BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On behalf of all eligible Local Education Agencies (LEAs), the California Department of Education (CDE) and the State Board of Education (SBE) jointly submitted eight waiver requests to the United States Department of Education (ED). These waiver requests pertain to Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) given the significant new funding for programs provided by the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) allocations for 2009-10.

CURRENT INFORMATION:

The District has planned to use ARRA funds over a two-year period for 2009-10 and 2010-11. If granted, the waiver request will enable the National School District to carryover more than 15 percent of its Title I, Part A, 2009 and 2010 allocations.
