Comments: Bubbles are an effective source of early learning because they are immediate, meaningful,

and involve children's discovery and choice. Many science processes such as, investigation, discovery, experimentation, observation, definition, comparison, and classification can be learned simply by playing with bubbles. Bubbles help children develop self-concept as they learn about themselves and the world around them, and language development is enhanced when children learn new words to describe bubbles,

explain tasks, and label and record bubble experiments.


