Dear Parents,

Registration for the REACH Before and After School Program for the 2025-2026 school year is here. Any family interested in REACH for 2025-2026 must fill out an application (even if you are currently enrolled in REACH or on the waiting list). Here are the important details, regarding the enrollment process:

REACH interest forms are available via <https://forms.office.com/r/CzGZg7qs1t>

April 14 – May 2, 2025 – REACH interest forms will be accepted for the enrollment process.

- Interest forms received before or after these dates will not be eligible for initial consideration.
- Interest forms must be submitted by an adult/parent guardian via link.
- Submitting an online interest form DOES NOT guarantee enrollment.
- YMCA Waiver must be completed through the interest form by the parent/ guardian and will be contacted by the YMCA.

Between **May 5 and May 9, 2025** all REACH applications will be reviewed by REACH staff and school personnel. Each REACH program has a maximum number of students that they are able to serve. Students will be enrolled based on the rating system detailed below, up to the capacity for each school's program. First priority for program enrollment will go to students who are identified by the program as "homeless youth" (as defined by the federal McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act) at the time that they apply for enrollment or at any time during the school year, and to students who are identified by the program as being in foster care. If the program receives more applications than spaces available, spaces will be offered to applications with the most points. Once the REACH program has reached its capacity, students not accepted for participation will be placed on a wait list, in the same order of priority, and will be accepted as space becomes available.

REACH Application Point System 25-26 School Year	
Unduplicated Student: Foster, McKinney Vento (Homeless), English Language Learner, and/or socioeconomically disadvantaged.	6 Points
Student has applied for the REACH program and will attend all 5 days of the week.	2 Points
Student has applied for the REACH program and will attend both the AM & PM program.	1 Point
Student participated in the REACH program during 2024-2025 and met at least 90% attendance overall.	2 Points
OR Student was enrolled on the waitlist in the 2024-2025 school year.	1 Point

After **May 3, 2025** – REACH Interest forms received after the initial enrollment period will be added to the wait list and enrolled if/when space is available.

May 23, 2025 – Participants will be contacted by the REACH Program via email with their enrollment status.
