# 1. Welcome and approval of minutes from September 10, 2020

- The members introduced themselves and shared how many years they have been a part of the Superintendent's Roundtable.

### 2. Roundtable and District Updates- Justin Finch

Dr. Brady thanked all Classified staff for their support during the Coronavirus pandemic and distance learning. She shared that the Board delayed the official start of hybrid instruction model until January 11<sup>th.</sup> As early as November 9<sup>th</sup> there will be students returning to campus for academic supports. Additional help will be hired to assist with student care. The district is targeting students under the following criteria to participate in the support on campus: special needs, homeless/foster care, English learners, and students with chronic absenteeism. There will be no more than 28 students per AM and PM shifts on site.
