COVID-19 Support

The Board approved two contracts that will support COVID-19 efforts in National School District:

#CT3877 WITH ACHIEVE HEALTH MANAGEMENT, LLC, TO ADMINISTER COVID-19 TESTING SERVICES

This contract will provide asynchronous in-district quarantine testing for identified students and staff.

#CT3881 WITH MAXIM HEALTHCARE STAFFING TO PROVIDE HEALTHCARE SERVICES FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

This contract will provide quarantine contact tracing, notification, and family support.
