## 6th Grade Camp

Mr. Richard Krudner, YMCA Outdoor Education Director- Camp Marston, engaged Trustees in a conversation regarding sixth grade students possibly attending outdoor education camp in the spring of 2022 (pending COVID-19 restrictions). Camp is currently operating at reduced capacity with COVID-19 precautions in place. Mr. Krudner shared that a reduced deposit would be allowed for this school year. If National School District is unable to attend due to COVID-19, the deposit would be applied to a future visit. The Board is expected to vote on the approval of the contracts on October 27, 2021.

## **Tentative Agreement**

A public hearing was held to review the cost of the Tentative Agreement between the Board of Education and National City Elementary Teachers Association (NCETA), effective July 2021. Ongoing costs included in the agreement was a 3% cost-of-living adjustment for all certificated employees and an increase of Health and Welfare benefits to \$15,280. Mr. Avanesyans attested to the ability for the District to maintain a positive budget for the next three years with this commitment. There were no public speakers to this item. The Governing Board subsequently approved the Tentative Agreement with a vote of 5-0.
