Job Description

The Governing Board unanimously approved a job description for Executive Director of Information Technology Services to support the restructuring of the technology department. The elimination of the Director of Literacies, Educational Technologies, and Innovation and Data Analyst positions will create a funding source for the Executive Director of Information Technology.

Pre-Authorization

The pre-authorization includes ten (10) temporary classroom teachers for the 2024-2025 school year. This pre-authorization to hire temporary teachers is valid through September 30, 2024.
